CLTAF Training Course & Curriculum Updates

Print Reading

The reading of construction prints is a foundational skill in construction. LiUNA members, regardless of what they may be working in the field, should know how to read prints. Print reading is not terribly difficult but it does require practice and some basic knowledge of construction prints.

This course is designed to provide our union members with that foundational knowledge and enough practice at reading prints to get members started. Mastery of print reading will come with practice and with using prints on the job on a regular basis.

CLTAF will now be offering this course as part of our continued education to Journeyworkers and will be 5 days (40 Hours).

This new 5-day training will include the following:

- **Constructions Drawings**
- **Lines and Symbols**
- **Plan Views**
- **Elevations Views**
- **Construction Materials**
- **Plot Plans**
- **Civil Prints**
- **Foundation Prints**
- **Commercial Prints**
- **Residential Prints**

Whether on paper or a CAD screen, many members looking at prints do not know how to read and understand these drawings. Prints are an integral part of our craft as a LiUNA member and your continued education in print reading could be a jumpstart for your career.
